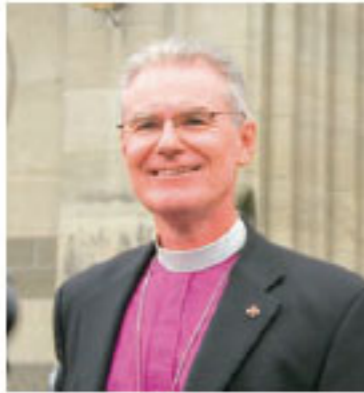


Building on our Foundation

History of the Foundation

The Foundation was established in 1987 by Archbishop David Penman to enable the development and funding of projects in the Anglican Diocese of Melbourne. The Foundation is based on a corpus of funds, generously provided by its members' contribution fees. The corpus is invested by a board of directors and provides an income stream to cover administration and staff costs and to provide for the distribution of grants to approved diocesan and parish projects. The structure of the Foundation also includes tax deductible Funds which enable parishes to run fundraising activities for approved projects.

The Directors of the Foundation consider applications for approval of tax deductible parish projects. Advice on fundraising is available from the Foundation office and in some cases seed grants are available to help establish the project.



Melbourne Anglican Cultural Organisation Inc.

Our newest Fund was established in 2006 to promote art and culture in the context of the Anglican Church. A wide range of creative activities may be considered for approval as tax deductible projects. To name a few – the performing and visual arts, film and design, choirs and music, literature and creative writing, ethnic, indigenous and community arts.

Migrants and Refugees Settlement Fund

This Fund was established to help refugees settle into a new life in Melbourne. Parishes may apply to support individuals in 'necessitous circumstances' and projects are approved which support emergency accommodation, material aid and skills and language classes. Also, ask us about the Jacob's Ladder Loan Fund, an interest free resettlement program.



Hospital Chaplaincy

The Fund supports Anglican chaplains in hospitals and aged care facilities. With donor support we provide grants for pilot programs in health and pastoral care chaplaincies in new areas of Melbourne.



Youth Ministry

This Fund supports youth ministry projects which benefit disadvantaged young people. We assist parishes to form partnerships with community groups and schools to offer activities such as camps, youth clubs and counselling programs.

Melbourne Anglican Benevolent Society Inc.

The Society approves parish projects which assist disadvantaged youth, families and individuals. Seeding grants are available for parishes to run homework clubs, meals programs, woodwork workshops and school breakfast clubs to name a few.
